PACS REVIEW

- Parks and Community Services Commission (PACS):
 - Presentation to PACS on May 14, 2026
 - Feedback received from PACS with direction to return on June 11, 2026

USER AND REGULATORY FEES

- Communities generally use tax revenues to fund services that provide general (community-wide) benefit
 - Public works
 - Public safety
 - Park maintenance
- Communities generally use fees and charges (direct recovery) to fund services that provide direct benefit
 - Plan Review
 - Permitting
 - Inspection

CITY STANDARD PRACTICE

- Fee schedule is reviewed annually as part of City standard operations.
- Comprehensive fee study is performed periodically
- Inflationary adjustment applied in years between comprehensive studies
- FY 2026/27 proposed fee schedule is based on results of recently completed comprehensive fee study

PURPOSE OF FEE REVIEW AND UPDATE

- Why do Cities Review Fees and Charge Fees for Services?

- Legal requirements
- Encourage direct recovery of costs incurred to serve private interests/benefit or respond to individual actions
- Provide opportunity for relief to General Fund or other Funds where costs are incurred
- Enable continuity of service levels by improving cost recovery levels

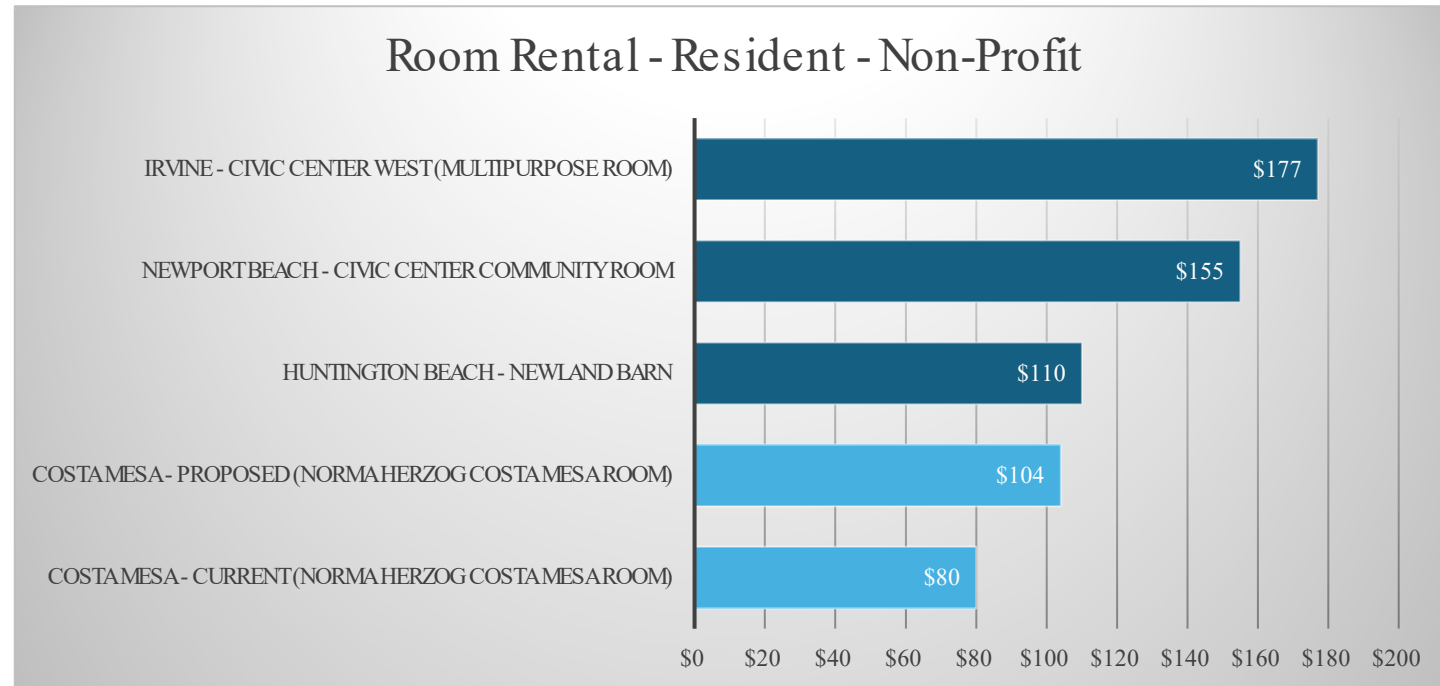
- **Recreation and Community Services Fees Only**

Description	Count	Percentage
Fees Proposed to Remain Unchanged	7	10.1%
New Fees	1	1.4%
Fees Proposed to Increase	59	85.5%
Fees with Changes that Vary Based on Project Criteria (May Result in Increase or Decrease)	2	3.0%
Total	69	100.0%

OVERVIEW OF PROPOSED FEE ADJUSTMENTS

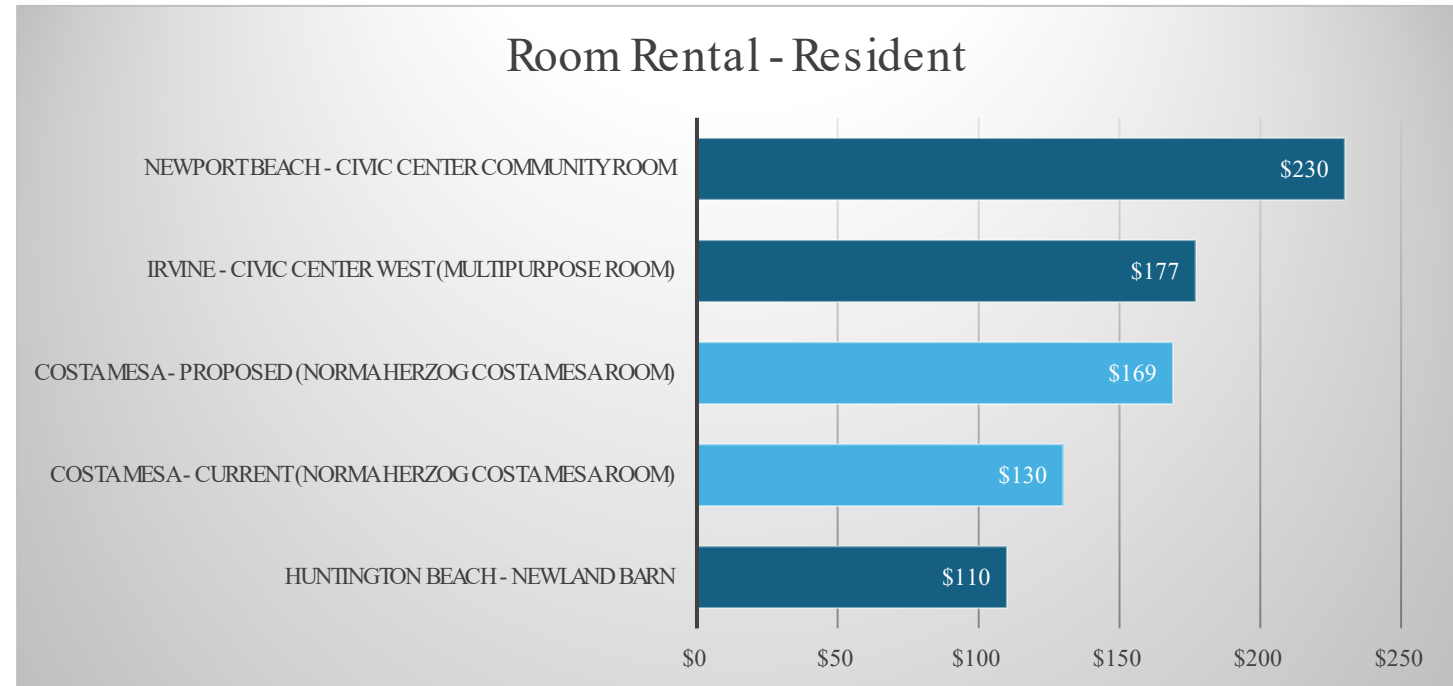
- Most fees are proposed to increase by 30%.
 - This represents the change in regional cost inflation since the last significant update of Recreation and Community Services Fees (January 1, 2019)
 - 30% adjustment represents an annualized change of approximately 4% since prior adjustment.
- Minor changes (5%) to resident youth programming fees
- Minor changes to senior aquatic use fees

REGIONAL FEE COMPARISON



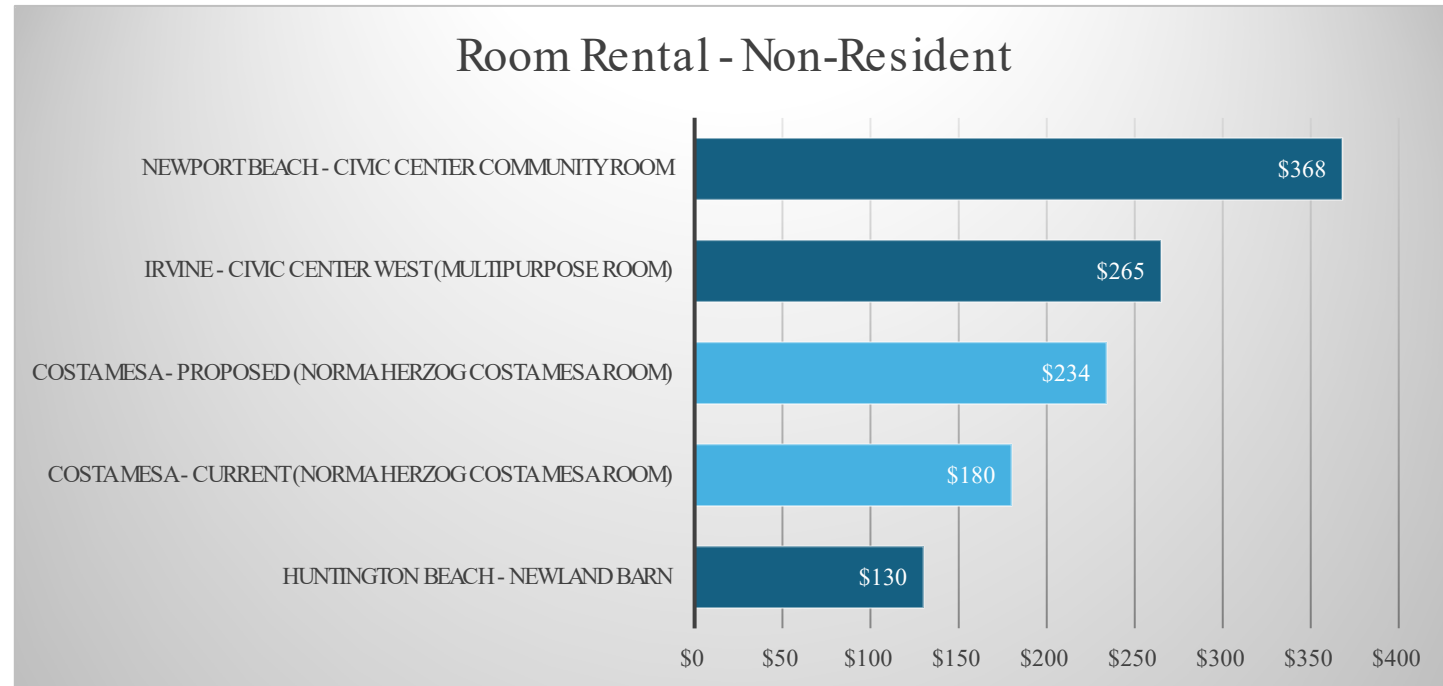
