❖ Fairview Park

- The City hosted its Second Saturday restoration day on Saturday, September 9, in partnership with the Fairview Park Alliance, focusing on the vernal pool 5/6/7 coastal sage scrub buffer area. The next Second Saturday restoration day is scheduled for Saturday, October 14.
- The City has partnered with the Banning Ranch Conservancy (BRC) in hosting additional monthly restoration days on the 3rd Saturday of each month. These 3rd Saturday Restoration days focus on the coastal sage scrub areas in the upper canyon. On Saturday, September 16, volunteers from the Banning Ranch Conservancy assisted in non-native plant removal activities. The City and BRC are planning on hosting a coastal sage scrub planting day in Fairview Park on Saturday, October 21.
- The Fairview Park Master Plan Update project team is preparing for its next community outreach session. The next meeting is tentatively scheduled for a date in November; time and location details will be provided to the Commission and distributed on the City's social media platforms once meeting details are confirmed.
