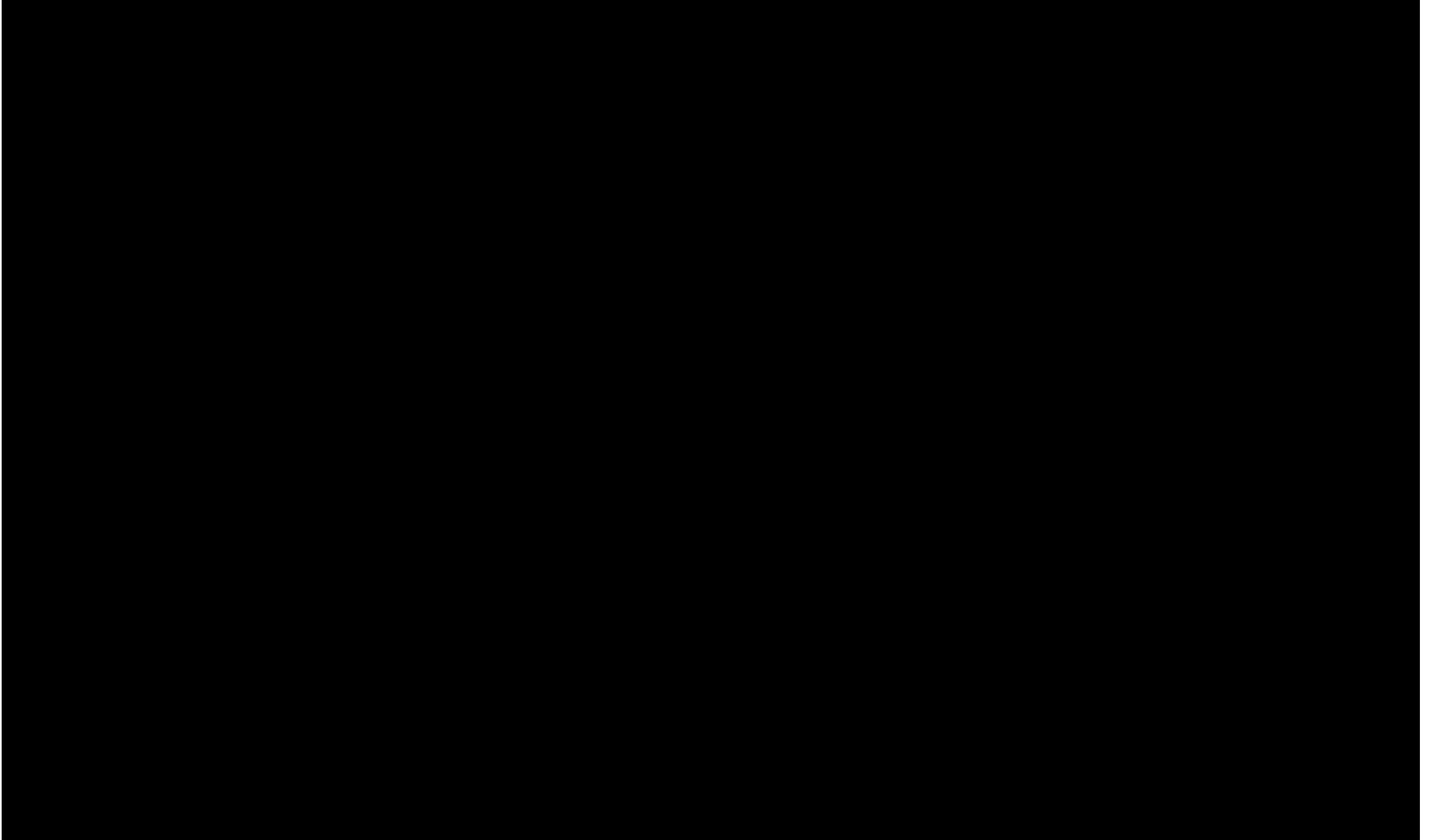


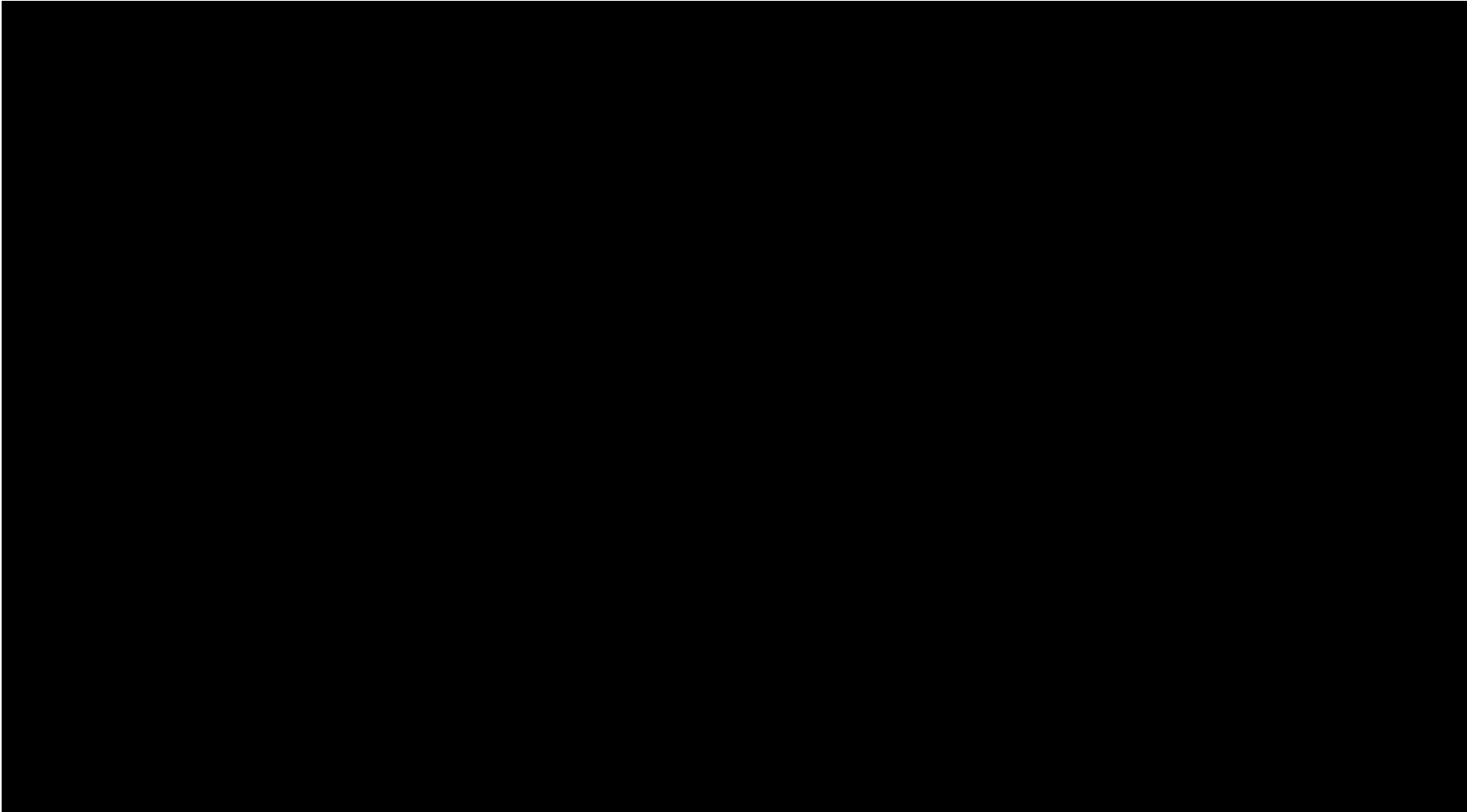

“Regular disturbance decreases the overall biological integrity of the park by favoring species that are more resilient and attracted to urban environments (e.g., crows, rats, mice, opossums, skunks). Species that are more sensitive to disturbance are likely to leave, reducing species diversity.”
