Thank you for your public comment. I wanted to clarify your questions from the email below.

The project will not involve any changes in the current land use including no physical improvements such as demolishing or expanding the existing buildings. The project involves a change in ownership of the property which also includes updating the conditions of approval from the original approval when the City approved the motel conversion to an affordable housing development. The property will remain an affordable housing development and no existing tenants will be impacted by the ownership change or updated conditions of approval. The new owner will be required by the City to continue to provide affordable units in perpetuity.
