BACKGROUND:

The City Council is represented on a number of committees, boards and agencies throughout the County. In most cases, the Mayor has the authority to appoint the Council representative. However, the by-laws of the Vector Control District require formal Council approval of the Mayor's appointment. The Vector Control appointment can be a resident of Costa Mesa that is registered to vote.
